

ORDER

On September 22, 2008, Petitioner, Sharon Bridgewater, submitted this habeas corpus action, apparently claiming ineffective assistance of counsel in connection with her guilty plea to various traffic violations. (Pet. at 1; see id., attaches.) Because it is unclear from her pleadings what relief Petitioner is seeking and whether she has exhausted her state court remedies with respect to her claims, the Court ordered Petitioner to execute and file a 28 U.S.C. § 2254 complaint form within thirty (30) days or face possible dismissal of this action. (Order [2] entered Oct. 2, 2008.)

To date, Petitioner has not submitted the complaint form as ordered. Therefore, pursuant to N.D. Ga. R. 41.3(A)(2), the Court **DISMISSES** this action **WITHOUT PREJUDICE** due to Petitioner's failure to obey a lawful Order of the Court.
