

Federal district courts "have original jurisdiction of all civil actions arising under the Constitution, laws, or treaties of the United States," 28 U.S.C. § 1331, and petitioner cites no authority that would allow for direct review of the challenged executive order in this court. The response to the order to show cause may not exceed the length limitations established by Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 27(d)(2) (5,200 words if produced using a computer; twenty pages if handwritten or typewritten). Failure to comply with this order will result in dismissal of the petition for review for lack of prosecution. See D.C. Cir. Rule 38.
